Stefanie lives in Pittsburgh, PA with her husband and two sons. She is a graduate of the New York Center for Arts and Media Studies and is a Certified Permaculture Designer.

Recent exhibitions include International Art Textile Biennale, traveling to 7 galleries in Australia, Tenuous Threads at Atlantic Gallery in New York City, and Fiberart International at Contemporary Craft in Pittsburgh, PA.
